

Mentor Program for Caregivers of Trans Youth: Procedures

Step One

Marketing

- A. Develop an <u>application</u> form for interested mentors/mentees to fill out (one application for mentors, one application for mentees).
- B. Create marketing/advertising tools (ie <u>flyers</u>) for the program and include important dates such as application deadline and the program launch date.
 - The flyer can also include a link or QR code that will take the mentor/mentee directly to the application.
- C. Advertise flyers for 3-4 weeks
 - Flyers can be advertised through social media, local businesses, schools, etc.

Step Two

The Matching Process

- D. The following guidelines should be considered when making mentor and mentee matches:
 - The young person of the mentor is older than the young person of the mentee; if this is not possible, look for a mentor and mentee who have young people of similar ages but where the mentor has been a caregiver to a trans/gender diverse youth longer

- The gender identities between the mentor/mentee's young person are similar (ex. both their young people are trans masculine)
- The experience of caregivers and their youth and where the youth/caregivers are in the stage of development/identity
- For example, a mentor who has a 12 year old who came out at 6 may have a lot of experience, but, the young person is still at a different stage than someone who is 16 and came out at 15
- Look for and prioritize any special requests (ex. A mentee of color prefers a mentor of color)

Email Communications (Once potential matches are identified)

Send an email to all mentors/mentees letting them know we have matched them with a mentor/mentee, and asking them to confirm their involvement in the program. Include the following in the email:

- For Mentors:

- Attach a google form with days and times for them to choose from for their mentorship training, or a link to this pre-recorded training:

- PART II
- Once time is decided, send out an <u>email</u> inviting them to the training, along with the following:
 - Mentor/mentee agreement form to be signed and sent back**
 - The Caregiver Mentoring Manual
 - The Caregiver Mentee Handouts

- For Mentees:

- Send email with Mentor/Mentee Agreement to have it signed and returned to us**
- Caregiver Mentee Handouts

- For All:

 Once confirmation is received and the agreements are signed, send mentors and mentees a google form with days and times for a mentor/mentee social

- Can have multiple social days. Does not have to be the same day/time for everyone. As long as our pairs are able to attend their social together
- Once days and times are selected, send out an <u>introductory email</u> to mentors and their mentees and invite them to their specific social day and time

Step Three

Mentor training

The training for mentors will take place after initial matches have been made and before the social

Three hours- schedule 1 training session. Have a recording of the training available for folks who are not able to attend. Have mentors bring their manuals for reference

Step Four

Mentor/Mentee Social

Orientation session for mentors and mentees; 30 minutes (not mandatory)

- Welcome all to the mentoring program,
- Review the agreement
- Allow mentor/mentee to greet each other and exchange contact information if they would like

Per the Mentor Training Manual: Mentors/Mentees are set to meet 1-2x monthly over the course of 5-6 months

 Meeting days/times and meeting location (in person or virtual) will be at the discretion of the mentor and mentee
